

WATERTOUR STRATEGY

SOME OF MAIN FINDINGS (1):

- EU funding can also be involved in river tourism product development
- The tourist infrastructure along the Tisza river needs further development (e.g. camping sites, water stops, shower cabins)
- The Tisza water hiking route can be developed by connecting the backwaters and canals
- The tourist attraction of nature would be further enhanced by the creation of new nature trails
- The creation of thematic and complex routes (e.g. public buildings, schools, churches, castles, gastronomy) would further increase the attractiveness of settlements.


WATERTOUR STRATEGY

SOME OF MAIN FINDINGS (2):

- It would be worthwhile to widen the range of leisure facilities and services at each of the water stops.
- Continuous improvement should also be made in the field of sports knowledge and tour organization, supported by universities and sports clubs.
- Motivating young people especially students from two major universities
- Involving the local population in sports and recreational activities
- Coordinated marketing communication, unified image
- The developments would also serve the recreational needs of the local population, and on the other hand, services (eg accommodation, hospitality, port services) could bring resources to the settlement, creating jobs.


